# Money & Movements Convening Hosted by the Count Me In! (CMI!) Consortium

Naivasha, Kenya, April 11-13, 2018

*We want to create a future in which feminist movements led by women, girls, trans & intersex people are strong, resilient and thriving.*

**What:** Hosted by the [Count Me In! Consortium](#), Money & Movements brings together activists & funders to strategise about the future of resourcing feminist movements and social change globally.

**Who:** The small gathering of ~100 participants includes leading women's, girls, trans and intersex activists from around the world and funders from a variety of sectors (bilateral/multilateral, public and private foundations, women's funds, etc.). Collectively, we work across a range of issues, including women's rights, LBQTI rights, youth, environmental and economic justice, health and more.

**How:** Money & Movements is designed to:

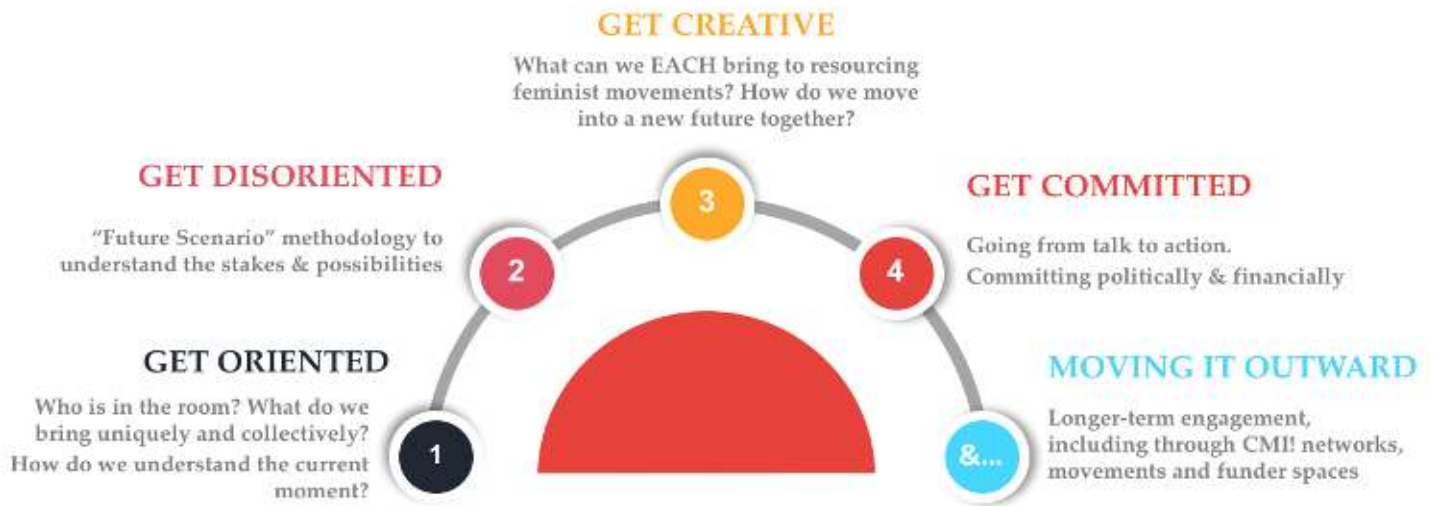
1. **Create a space of reflection, analysis, deep listening and challenging.** In this space, we aim to build collective understanding of good practice and priorities for resourcing feminist movements (including financial, political and other resources) in light of current contexts and dynamics around the world;
2. **Disrupt typical power dynamics** (e.g. between funders and activists, Global North and Global South, English-speaking and not, etc.) so we can each engage creatively and powerfully;
3. **Create transformative moments** that lead to: a) new understandings; b) new collaborations; and c) new strategies to resource feminist movements; and
4. **Bring NEW money and news ways of resourcing to the table**, including after the convening.

*The convening is part of a larger process toward these goals.*

In addition, the methodology is guided by **two overarching principles**:

- **Inclusivity:** Participants represent the rich diversity of feminist movements around the world and the convening is designed to be accessible (language, ability, identity) and welcoming for all participants.
- **Creativity:** To bring our boldest, most expansive and visionary thinking, the design incorporates creative forms of expression and sharing, including performative spaces, connection outside of sessions, and wellness woven throughout.
